Reflecting on Our Journey: Sharing Experiences from the past few years

Over the past few years, Myanmar has faced significant socio-political changes and economic challenges. The resilience of the Myanmar people in overcoming these difficulties has been both surprising and inspiring. During this period, the Center for Vocational Training (CVT) also faced numerous challenges, which it successfully navigated.

Between 2019 and 2023, CVT completed both theoretical and practical courses for first, second, and third-year students under its Dual Apprenticeship program. Additionally, two rounds of surveys were conducted with our collaborative companies. For those young individuals unable to attend CVT in person, we provided basic vocational education through free online videos via the MPT CSR platform. Furthermore, courses on occupational safety and health were delivered to teachers and students in partnership with Win OSH Myanmar.

In 2023, having fully implemented the commitments outlined in the MOUs signed with the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Labour, CVT returned its school area and buildings to the respective ministries. As a result, the school was relocated, and CVT transitioned into a nonprofit socio-economic enterprise, now registered with the Department of Investment and Company Administration.

Today, CVT is fully managed by a board of Myanmar nationals, along with local administrators and experts who continue to lead its operations. Following the passing of Mr. Heini Portmann, President of CVT and the Swiss Support Association (SSA), at the end of 2023, Mr. Stefan Gregor Vogler has assumed the role of SSA President. As a partner association of CVT, SSA remains committed to supporting those in need of quality vocational education through new training programs, offered under an effective cost-sharing system.

Contributing to the Development of the TVET Sector

As we work to shape the future of TVET and Apprenticeship Education, CVT remains committed to building a strong foundation for youth, fostering cooperation between employers and employees, and creating development opportunities with our collaborative partners. While many challenges lie ahead, new opportunities continue to emerge.

For the advancement of vocational education, it is essential to combine education with social accountability. Continuous support from our collaborative organizations is particularly crucial in this effort. We deeply appreciate your long-standing commitment to CVT and your contributions to our mission.

We look forward to your ongoing support as we work together with CVT towards the sustainable development of our youth and the TVET sector. We will continue to keep our partners informed by sending newsletters every six months.

Training Activities

Return of YE4M - Young Entrepreneurs for Myanmar

Aimed at young professionals and aspiring business leaders, the Center for Vocational Training (CVT) Myanmar successfully conducted 20 batches of the Young Entrepreneurs for Myanmar (YE4M) program from 2014 to 2018. After a pause due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the 21st batch of YE4M was relaunched on January 27, 2024, with 12 trainees, in collaboration with Pace Forward at their training hall.

On March 23, 2024, participants, divided into three groups, presented their business plans on topics including Burma Society (Bar), BONNY Clothing, and Housewife Canning Industry. The two-month training concluded with a graduation ceremony held on March 30, 2024, at SEEDS Restaurant & Lounge.

CVT extends heartfelt gratitude to SEEDS Restaurant & Lounge for their generous support in helping relaunch this program, as well as for providing space and refreshments during the graduation ceremony.





Occupational Safety and Health (OSH) Training

With the goal of spreading knowledge on Common Occupational Safety & Health (OSH), CVT successfully conducted OSH training in North Dagon and Tharkayta Townships, where CVT operates. From January to March 2024, four batches of training were held, benefiting around 180 participants from Labor Asia Training Center and Great Explore Company Limited. The training was led by CVT teachers and aimed to enhance safety practices in the workplace.













Basic Food Safety and Hygiene Awareness Training

From January 9 to 13, 2024, CVT successfully conducted a Basic Food Safety and Hygiene Awareness Training for 26 participants from The First Harmony Restaurant. The training aimed to enhance participants' knowledge of essential food safety practices and hygiene standards.





Summer Short Term Courses

In March and April 2024, CVT offered two-month short courses in computer skills and basic English. A total of 25 participants, including novices, nuns from Kyauk Chaung Monastery School, and external students, took part in the training. The graduation ceremony was held on April 30, 2024, where certificates were awarded to the graduates.

Opening of Electrician Profession Training

In collaboration with the Center for Vocational Training and Labor Asia Training Center, the Electrical Installation Course (NSSA Level 1) was successfully launched for individuals seeking both theoretical and practical training at CVT in North Dagon Township on May 6, 2024. The course covered essential topics, including Basic Electrical Safety, Distribution Systems, Domestic Installation, Earthing Systems, and House Wiring Rules.

The graduation ceremony for the course was held on May 24, 2024, celebrating the achievements of the participants.

CVT Alumni Gathering


